INTRODUCTION

1. Purpose

Trinity Metals Group is committed to implementing high environmental management standards across all its operations. We believe that by maintaining high standards, mining will positively influence social and economic development. We acknowledge that mining operations can positively and negatively impact the environment. Still, we are committed to minimising the adverse effects by ensuring that our environmental management programs are integral to our business plans.

2. Application

This policy applies to Trinity Metals and all affiliated companies (Trinity Metals Group). It applies to all personnel of the Trinity Metals Group, whether Directors, Employees, Consultants or Contractors, and whether working part-time or full-time on Trinity Metals business ("Trinity Metals personnel").

3. Commencement

This policy applies from September 2022.

4. Authority and Management

The Board of Directors approved this policy and will review it periodically, not less than every two years or any other time deemed necessary.

POLICY

Trinity Metals Group Limited and its affiliated companies are committed to the following:

- Establishing and maintaining a safe working environment and a positive working relationship with local stakeholders.
- Ensuring that all employees, subsidiaries, suppliers, contractors, sub-contractors, consultants and sub-consultants demonstrate a commitment to the aims of these Standards.
- Complying with relevant environmental, legal, and regulatory requirements and maintaining an up-to-date register of all applicable legislation.
- Evaluating the environmental risks associated with our activities to take appropriate actions to minimise and mitigate potential risks and impacts.
- Developing and implementing a comprehensive environmental monitoring program at our operations and using the data to make informed decisions regarding our business activities.
- Preventing pollution, avoiding or minimising waste generation by actively promoting reuse, recycling and resource efficiency. All waste generated will be managed and disposed of responsibly.
- Educating, training and motivating employees to carry out tasks in an environmentally and socially responsible manner.
- Maintaining a plan for the eventual closure of our operations, including management of social and environmental impacts, estimates of closure costs and financial provision.
- Developing, implementing and maintaining management systems and procedures to identify, monitor, report and control existing and potential mine impacts and risks to the environment.
- Seeking continual improvement through setting and reviewing environmental

objectives and targets, assessing and reporting environmental performance.

- Using energy and other natural resources as efficiently as possible.
- Protect and conserve biodiversity, fauna and flora as far as possible and aim for zero impact on the areas in which we operate.
